## Additional Performance Credit Calculations and Supplemental Information

Describe below the progress made in meeting your program year work plan inspection goals. You must provide quantitative results for each compliance inspection and land application goal listed in your work plan.

Overall, Lyon County exceeded the minimun requirment of 7% (20) inspection rate and inspected 21 feedlots.

Lyon County Inspected 5 sites proposing construction or expansion (met goal), 4 sites with a construction short form (met goal), and 15 sites required to be registered that have never been expected (exceeds goal of 13). Theses goals were required inspection strategies. Lyon County inspected 4 sites that have not been maintaining adequate land application records and/or manure management plans (exceeds goal of 3), 21 sites that are within a WRAPS/TMDL area (exceeds goal of 4), 8 sites using the 5 year rotating basis strategie (exceeds goal of 3), and 15 sites that have never been inspected focusing on open lots (exceeds goal of 3). Lyon county conducted a total of 23 inspections, which did not need the inspection stategy goal of 35. With the large amount of rainfall in 2018, staff was inudated with soil erosion and water storage projects. Lyon County will strive to reach the indicated goal of 35 inspections in 2019.
