

**ATTENTION:** Curbside recycling collection occurs every week. Set cart out the evening before collection day. Keep 3' between recycling cart, garbage cart, mailbox or other objects so the truck's mechanical 'hands' can efficiently grab the cart & empty it. ☞ Place recyclables loose in cart with the exception of shredded paper & plastic bags. Refer to instructions below for details.

☞ Rural residents—place recyclables loose in the containers at the recycling drop-off sites located in each town in the county with the exception of shredded paper & plastic bags. (Instructions below.) Containers marked 'cardboard only' should be used only for cardboard/paper items.

**ALUMINUM**

Pop/beer cans—empty & dry  
Pie pans/trays—clean & dry

Burnt or dirty cans  
Dirty pans/trays  
Cookware Scrap metal



**TIN CANS**

(Can lids are acceptable)  
Empty & clean  
No need to remove labels

Screw-on lids  
Aerosol cans  
Paint cans  
Cookware Wire  
Hangers Scrap metal



**GLASS BOTTLES/JARS from food & beverages**

Unbroken clear, brown, green, blue  
Empty & clean  
Remove & discard caps  
No need to remove labels

Light bulbs, mirrors,  
window glass, dishes,  
drinking glasses, coffee  
cups/mugs, ceramics,  
bowls, vases, etc.



**PLASTIC CONTAINERS**

Plastic bottles/jugs/containers coded with the recycling symbol.  
Must be empty/ clean of liquid or food waste.  
Remove & discard caps, covers or lids  
No need to remove labels  
***\*\*Empty & clean plastic bags such as shopping bags & dry cleaning bags are acceptable. Please place bags into a similar type bag and knot it shut.***

Containers without symbol & number. Hoses/pipes. Toys. 'Clamshell' containers from salads, cookies, sandwiches, etc.  
Containers that held hazardous materials  
Hangers  
NO Styrofoam items  
NO medical waste of any kind  
NO diapers



**NEWSPAPER & HOME/OFFICE PAPER**

Dry & clean  
EXAMPLES of Acceptable items:  
Magazines & catalogs, writing paper, junk mail, envelopes, computer/copy paper

Dirty or greasy paper items. Paper towels/tissues/napkins/ toilet paper. Food wrappers. Waxed paper. Plastic lined envelopes.



**CARDBOARD & Paper Grocery Bags**

Break down & flatten cardboard boxes

Wet or dirty cardboard boxes or paper bags



**PAPERBOARD PACKAGING**

Examples: Cereal, cracker, macaroni, cake boxes. Remove & discard liners, cellophane, plastic, or metal edges.  
Empty milk cartons & juice boxes—remove & discard caps & straws. Do not crush carton.

Ice cream cartons, margarine boxes, pizza cartons, frozen dinner boxes, pop/ beer cartons
