MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING Lyon Soil & Water Conservation District Tuesday, June 23, 2015 – 12:00 P.M.

Chair Gary Crowley called the meeting to order at 12:10 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Deutz, Crowley, Prairie, Lavoy, Meulebroeck, Stensrud, L. Olson, A. Cauwels, J. Biren, T.Bruse, J. Thomazin and Jason Beckler from BSWR.

Motion by Meulebroeck, Seconded by Deutz to approve the agenda with the addition of Cover Crop/Alternative Intakes requested by A. Deutz under New Business listed as D. Board Conflicts- Deutz. All voted in favor, motion passed.

Motion by Lavoy, seconded by Meulebroeck, to approve the May 26, 2015 minutes as presented. Board Conflicts – None. All voted in favor, Motion passed.

Motion by Meulebroeck, seconded by Deutz to approve the Financial Reports. All voted in favor, Motion passed.

Old Business:

A. <u>James Carr</u> – Luke Olson gave a presentation on the project. Land is rented and operated by Dick Carrow and owned by James Carr. Project consists of 3 basins. Tile is working and there is no drown out spots. Ask the board for an amendment due to not being able to put in tile last fall. 1st Contract is a total of\$ 3,381.10, which is 75% share of\$ 4,508.13. Landowner share is \$1,127.03. 2nd Contract is a total of \$7,010.15, which is 75% of \$9,346.87. Landowner share is \$2,336.72. Amendment and Payments to approve made by Deutz, seconded by Meulebroeck to pay both amounts and amend the contract.

New Business:

- A. <u>Sam Tutt Well Sealing</u> Needed to seal well because Property was transferred and flagged by Department of Health. The well is a 6", 213' deep well with submersible pump. Sam is looking for assistance to pay for well sealing. Motion by Deutz, seconded by Prairie to deny payment due to past policies and not a safety or environmental concern. All voted in favor. Motion passed.
- B. <u>David Caup-Well Sealing</u>- No bills to approve at this time.
- C. <u>PF Reimbursement for Tanner Bruse</u> We owe \$5,000.00 to Pheasants Forever with in the Memorandum of Understanding with Pheasants Forever. Motion by Meulebroeck and seconded by Prairie to approve the payment.
- D. Cover Crop/Alternative Intake Discussion -Allen Deutz was taking about a 2 year Pilot Project. Funding through a private grant. He informed the board that he is having a Field Day to be held on September 18, 2015.
