- a. **Cottonwood Lake Shoreland Stabilization Project #31/19-Discussion and Approval** Project was brought to the board in 2016, but no further discussion was made until recently. The stabilization will protect from further erosion and silt going into Cottonwood Lake. Motion by Meulebroeck, 2nd by Prairie to approve Cost Share Contract in the amount of \$9,500.00 for Lyon SWCD. \$2.500.00 for Yellow Medicine Watershed District is approved. Landowner amount is \$10,000.00 which is being paid by County Ditch 69. Project total is \$22,000.00. Motion by Laleman, 2nd by Lanoue to pay Cost Share Contract in the amount of \$9,500.00. All in favor, motion carried.
- b. Adam Karbo #27/19 Well Sealing Contract Approval Motion by Prairie 2nd by Laleman to approve Well Sealing Contract in the amount of \$387.50 which is 50% of \$775.00 per Well Sealing Policy. All in favor, motion carried
- c. **Jim Vandendriessche #28/19 Cost Share Encumber Funds Approval-** Motion by Prairie, 2nd by Lanoue to approve Cost Share Contract in the amount of \$7,367.48 which is 75% of the total amount of \$9,823.30. Landowner total of \$3,566.86 for a Water & Sediment Control Basin & Underground Outlet. All in favor, motion carried.

- g. **Spencer Kor Streambank Stabilization -#30/19 Cost Share Encumber Funds Approval** Rip-rap to stabilize the streambank. Motion by Prairie, 2nd by Lanoue to approve Cost Share Contract in the amount of \$24,000.00 which is 75% of the total \$32,000.00. Landowner amount of \$8,000.00. All in favor, motion carried. After motion was made, suggestion by Biren to bring to the County Board to see if they would approve taking Cost Share out of County Riparian Funds. Biren will bring to the next County Board meeting.
- h. Resolution #03-2019 Des Moines River Watershed 1W1P Project Approval to sign resolution Commitment to be part of the application for the Des Moines River Watershed One Watershed One Plan. Motion by Prairie, 2nd by Laleman to sign resolution. All in favor, motion carried.
- i. Larry Vavruska #29/19 Well Sealing Contract Approval Motion by Lanoue 2nd by Prarie to approve Well Sealing Contract in the amount of \$337.50 which is 50% of \$675.00 per Well Sealing Policy. All in favor, motion carried.
