BIG IMPACT

- 1. Keep hazardous waste out of our landfill. Many appliances contain PCB's (a hazardous waste), and refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners have CFC's that contribute to ozone depletion.
- Upgrading appliances to more energy-efficient products reduces energy consumption.
- 3. Recycling metal components saves landfill space. Metals and fluids are captured and recycled through a different company.
