HARD COVER BOOKS

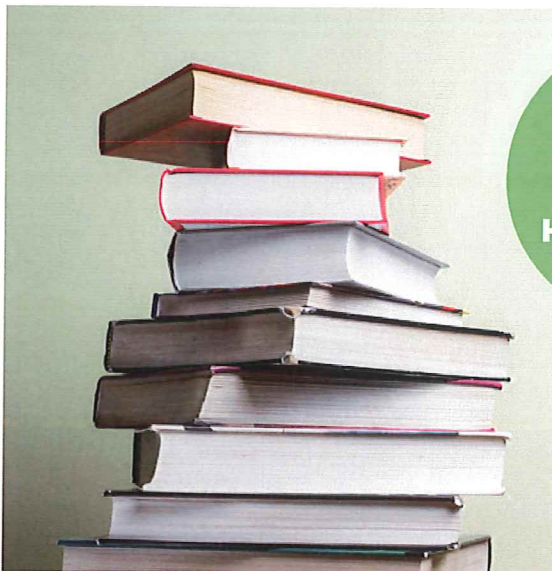
