Small Effort: Dispose of pesticides/herbicides by taking them to the Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) facility or Landfill.

Waste Pesticides/Herbicides

Waste pesticides/herbicides can be brought to the Lyon County HHW Facility and are disposed of through a contract with the MN Dept. of Agriculture. The contract allows qualifying participants (farmers, pesticide applicators, etc.) to dispose of their Waste Pesticides at no charge.

• Call the Lyon County Environmental Dept. at 507-532-8210 to find out if you qualify.

Please call ahead if you have amounts greater than 100 lbs. or containers larger than 5 gallons so preparations can be made to handle the waste. 507-532-8210





NO FEE

Empty Pesticide Container Disposal

Empty pesticide containers can be brought to the Lyon County Landfill during normal operation hours from June 1—August 31.

- Containers must be empty, clean, triple rinsed, caps and labels removed.
- Containers must be loose (not tied together).
- When delivering to the landfill please provide approx. number of containers.
