## Additional Performance Credit Calculations and Supplemental Information

Describe below the progress made in meeting your program year work plan inspection goals. You must provide quantitative results for each compliance inspection and land application goal listed in your work plan.

Lyon County met or exceeded all inspection goals for 2021. Lyon County inspected 23 sites, exceeding the goal of 20 from the work plan. 1 Feedlots within shoreland were inspected, and 6 Feedlots with the Yellow Medicine 1W1P were inspected. This exceeds the workplan goal of 5 sites inspected with shoreland, DWSMA, WRAPS, TMDL or 1W1P areas. 19 feedlots with open lots were inspection in 2020, exceeding the workplan goal of 10 sites that have open lots without runoff controls. 5 sites that according to previous inspections, have not been maintaining adequate land application records were inspected. This meets the work plan goal of 5. 12 sites that are required to be registered that have never been inspected were inspection by Lyon County in 2020. This exceeds the work plan goal of 5. All inspections were entered into TEMPO in a timely manner, contain the required documentation, and documentation has been uploaded to TEMPO.
