Encumbered amount of \$4,029.98 will be out of FY 2021 Conservation Delivery, \$183.09 out of FY 2020 Local Capacity, \$5,513.133 out of FY 2021 Local Capacity and \$7,524.55 out of FY 2022 Local Capacity.
