

Construction & Demolition Waste

Small Effort: Separate your construction/demolition (C&D) waste from landfill waste.

Construction/Demolition (C&D) waste ONLY includes materials used to build or remodel a home. If you can sort out your C&D waste you can save money on disposal cost. But if this is not practical all waste can enter the landfill.

BIG IMPACT

Save money! Tipping fees for C&D waste are half the cost of trash. Why? Household and industrial waste landfills cost more to construct and operate.

Help others in the community. Donate usable items to Habitat for Humanity for reuse – a majority of waste can be recycled or diverted from jobsites.

Keep trash collection prices lower. Locally, if C&D waste is separated from household waste, this will prolong the lifespan of the landfill and save money from expense of a new one.

Lyon County Landfill is a collection point for C&D waste which gets transported to another location.
